Project Description	This research is part of the Korea Institute of Public Administration (KIPA) 2020 Joint Research Project under the subject, "COVID-19 Response System and International Cooperation". For the Philippines, it will examine how the country responded to the COVID-19 crisis and to what extent its response system has mitigated the spread and cushioned the effects of this pandemic outbreak.
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Project Objective	This research will investigate the COVID-19 policy measures (short, medium, and long-term) at the national level, the manner by which these policies were cascaded and implemented at the local level, and their results (intermediate outcomes). The research will also explore how the Philippines leveraged partnership with the private sector and bilateral and multilateral cooperation to optimize its response to the COVID19 pandemic.

Lessons Learned	Since the timeline was too tight, it would have been better if the team was able to hire technical consultants to do the data encoding and cleaning as well as transcription. There were slight delays in the actual data gathering given that the other team members have prior commitments. While this research was a spade work, the team

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was able to manage through and submit the final manuscript on the deadline.


