The training was output-oriented, enabling attendees to develop draft research components including titles, abstracts, and frameworks. Overall, the course supported institutional goals by advancing faculty competencies in research writing and publication.

1. Many participants were new to systematic reviews, so it helped to begin with the basics of research before moving on to more complex topics.
2. Activities like exercises, tool demos, and one-on-one feedback worked better than just lectures from the resource persons.
3. Participants needed extra help getting used to tools like R, SEMINR, and VOSviewer. A short pre-workshop guide or orientation could make this easier.
4. Being able to ask questions and get guidance from experienced resource persons helped participants feel more confident and better understand the material.
5. Having sample formats for things like abstracts, research questions, and literature reviews made it easier for participants to put what they learned into practice.
